- 3) Malaysia Bank Account (FPX)

STEP BY STEP

Kineticpay Dashboard

- 1) Do access via <http://dashboard.kineticpay.my>
- 2) Click the “Collection” and “Add New Collection” as shown below:



Add New Collection:


- 3) Collection Name for example = kedai baju
- 4) URL for example = baju.com.my
- 5) Do you subscribe to Kinetic products for this collection?
If Yes, please select the product and get a settlement for the next day.
If No, the settlement will be delayed 7 days.
- 6) Click the “save” button.

7) Get the WordPress file from GitHub by clicking the “Get WordPress Plugin”.




8) Download the zip file and upload it to the WordPress plugin and activate.

9) Download the kineticpay-public.zip




10) Click Plugins

11) Choose the file and upload the Kinetipay-public.zip to your WordPress plugin. Then activate.



12) Then set up your Kinetipay by entering your Merchant Key from Collection.




13) Select "WooCommerce".

14) Click the payments button.


15) Copy Merchant key from Kinetipay and paste it to plugin WordPress Kinetipay.

16) Save changes.




Note: Do check and make sure the Kinetipay has been activated on page setting WooCommerce payments.

- 17) Enable the Kineticpay option.
- 18) Save changes.
